AIA NEW YORK CHAPTER ANNOUNCES 2014 DESIGN AWARD WINNERS

The recipients of the 2014 AIA New York Chapter Design Awards were announced Monday, March 3 at 6pm. The announcement was followed by a discussion of winning projects by jury members, which was moderated by Susan S. Szenasy, Hon. AIANY, Publisher/Editor-in-Chief of Metropolis.

NEW YORK CITY, March 5, 2014 – On March 3, 2014, twelve eminent architects, landscape architects, educators, critics, and planners convened at the Center for Architecture to select the winners of the 2014 AIA New York Chapter Design Awards. That night, they publicly announced the 35 winning projects at a symposium at the Center for Architecture, 536 LaGuardia Place. The conversation was moderated by Susan S. Szenasy, Hon. AIANY, Publisher/Editor-in-Chief of *Metropolis*.

The selected projects and the architecture firms that designed them – many of whom were on hand for the program – represent the exceptional work by AIA New York Chapter members and other architects practicing in New York City in four categories: Architecture, Interiors, Projects, and Urban Design. There was great variety in the winners, which ranged from small installations to large projects.

According to AIANY Executive Director Rick Bell, FAIA, "Among the winners were well-established stalwart firms, such as Pei Cobb Freed & Partners and many newer and emerging firms starting to make an impact on New York's skyline, including SLO Architecture, WORKac, and Slade Architecture."

Each winning project, granted either an "Honor" or "Merit" award, was chosen for its design quality, response to context and community, program resolution, innovation, thoughtfulness, and technique. Submissions had to be completed by AIANY members, architects/designers practicing in New York, or be New York projects designed by architects/designers based elsewhere. There were 384 entries in four categories, including 178 submissions in the Architecture category alone.

AIANY, was "impressed by the jury that AIA New York attracted and the judges' commitment to elevate their profession through honest discourse, as well as participating in awards programs like the ones they were judging." The moderated discussion that followed the announcements touched upon the state of architecture in New York City and the state of architectural competitions, among other topics.

The juries conferred 35 awards, including five Honor Awards in Architecture, two in Interiors, four in Projects, and two in Urban Design. The jurors and full list of winners follows.

All winning work will be exhibited in the *Design Awards* exhibition at the Center for Architecture beginning **Thursday, April 24**, with an opening reception from 6-8pm. The exhibition will remain on view through Friday, June 13. Exhibition design by [PS New York](#).

The Luncheon will also fete **Medal of Honor** recipients **Denise Scott Brown, RIBA, Int. FRIBA** and **Robert Venturi, FAIA, Int. FRIBA**; **Award of Merit** recipient **David Burney, FAIA**; and **Stephen A. Kliment Oculus Award** recipient **Susan S. Szenasy, Hon. AIANY**. The Luncheon serves as an important fundraiser for the AIA New York Chapter and our ongoing mission to show that design matters.

The **Design Awards Honor Winners' program** is scheduled for Thursday, May 22 at 6pm at the Center for Architecture.
