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

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

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

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### SUBMISSION CHECKLIST

#### **Application Form**

- *Cover Page Form:* The cover page form must be placed on the front of hard copy submissions.
- *Statement of Purpose:* In approximately 1,000 words outline the proposed travel plans. Discuss the value of these plans to the individual applicant and describe their significance to the applicant's professional development.
- *Resume:* Include your academic background, degree in architecture and date, and a brief outline of professional experience with role in projects and/or firm. Maximum length is three pages. *Please do not submit a portfolio of work samples.*
- *Budget:* Include all expenses associated with proposed travel plans such as transportation, visa fees, room and board, and admission fees.

#### **Portfolio**

Portfolios must be submitted electronically and demonstrate a range of the applicant's design projects. Applicant's portfolio should be no longer than 10 pages and the file limit is 5MB. These samples are expected to be of professional quality and are very important factors in the evaluation process.

#### **Supporting Material**

Applicants are not required to submit supporting material. Supporting material may consist of additional background information about the applicant, destination, or topic of interest.

#### **Two Letters of Recommendation**

All letters of recommendation must be signed and on letterhead. Letters should be written in support of the proposed travel plans and attest to the applicant's capability and professional promise. Letters must be signed. One letter must be written by a member of the American Institute for Architects (AIA).

#### **Entry Fee**
